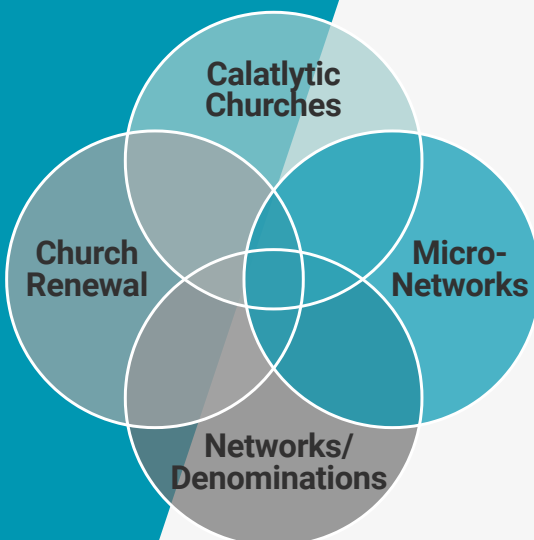

Micro-Networks are Critical to Transformation.

To see the spiritual landscape of New England transformed, we need this generation of leaders to see Kingdom collaboration as a lived reality and not just an aspirational dream.

As a region with only a handful of large churches, we cannot rely solely on a single church planting another church. Small collectives of 3-10 churches working together around a shared burden are essential to the multiplication ecosystem in our region.

The Multiplication Engine



Catalytic Churches:

Larger churches resisting the trend of church consolidation as centers of sending.

Micro-Networks:

Collectives of 3-10 churches focused on multiplication.

Networks/Denominations:

Established networks sharing ideas, resources, and even church plants as we seek first the Kingdom.

Church Renewal:

Finding health, rediscovering mission, or replanting.

How We Help

Coaching & Facilitation:

We plan and coordinate your first retreat and walk closely with the network leader throughout the journey.

Relational Resources & Problem Solving:

We bring the vast resources of our relational network to provide counsel, frameworks, and solve problems.

Pay It Forward to Your First Plant:

We ask each founding church to invest \$1,500 in the 521 Collaborative for the incubator process. These resources will fund your first retreat and coaching. We will pay back 100% of these funds when you plant your first church.

Micro-Network Incubator

It all begins with a shared burden for a **people** or **place**.

“When [Jesus] saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.” - Matthew 9:36

Micro-networks are friends on mission who share a burden and affinity that allow for deep partnership.

Common affinities include:

- Geographic: a city or town.
- Demographic: rural or under-resourced.
- Model: type of church, or style of ministry.
- Theological: corporate convictions and distinctives.

PHASE ONE FORMATION & CLARIFICATION

Clarify the identity, roles, commitments, rhythms, and missing pieces for the collective to thrive and plant churches together.

PHASE TWO MOMENTUM & COLLABORATION

Live as friends on mission, seeking the Lord, solving problems, and investing in the rising leaders who will be sent to to plant.

PHASE THREE MULTIPLICATION & CELEBRATION

Send out a church plant and support it with prayer, people, funds, coaching, and celebrate together!
